

MOTION NO: **5093**

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$290,080 to support building improvements to the White Center Field House, Grant File No. 055:2.

WHEREAS, the Urban Park and Recreation Recovery Act of 1978, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Department of the Interior, Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service, and

WHEREAS, improvements to the White Center Field House will assist the County in meeting the needs of citizens of the Burien, Highline and White Center areas for a safe recreational facility, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$124,320 as a cash match in support of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$290,090 to the Department of the Interior, Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service for improvements to the White Center Field House on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;


3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.


