

MOTION NO. 5115

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an agreement with the City of Bellevue and the City of Redmond for the purpose of developing a land use plan for the unincorporated area north of Bel-Red Road.

WHEREAS, the unincorporated area north of Bel-Red Road is an island of unincorporated King County which is proposed for annexation by Redmond and Bellevue, and

WHEREAS, King County and the Cities of Bellevue and Redmond recognize that land use decisions affecting this area have far reaching effects on these jurisdictions, and a joint study of land use alternatives leading to adoption of a joint land use policy for this area would be of benefit to the parties and to affected citizens, and

WHEREAS, a land use study of this area has been proposed by the parties to this Agreement in order to develop a coordinated land use plan and basis for annexation that is acceptable to all jurisdictions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Executive is authorized to enter into and carry out the provisions of an agreement in substantially the same form as is attached hereto by and between KING COUNTY, THE CITY OF BELLEVUE and THE CITY OF REDMOND to develop a land use plan and basis of annexation acceptable to all parties for the unincorporated area north of Bel-Red Road.
