MOTION NO.

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Snohomish County to provide for solid waste disposal services for the Skykomish Transfer Station.

WHEREAS, the King County Council by its Ordinance No. 2918 adopted the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan on October 4, 1976, and;

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Plan recommends the closure of the Skykomish dump and its replacement with the most practical and economical program, and;

WHEREAS, the King County Council by its Motion No. 3633, adopted July 31, 1978, approved the feasibility study titled "Solid Waste Disposal Alternatives for the Skykomish Area" and its reommendation for the construction of a transfer station to serve the County residents and Town residents in the Skykomish area, and;

WHEREAS, based on existing roadways, the Skykomish area of King County is integrally linked with Snohomish County, and;

WHEREAS, the final disposal of solid waste from King County's Skykomish Transfer Station can be done most safely and efficiently at Snohomish County's Cathcart Sanitary Landfill, and;

WHEREAS, the approved feasibility study recognizes the need for an Interlocal Agreement with Snohomish County to provide for disposal of solid waste from the Skykomish Transfer Station at a Snohomish County facility:
