2 A MOTION adopting the 1981 Annual Housing Action Plan,
3 and authorizing the County Executive to submit the Plan
4 with the Seventh Year Housing and Community Development
5 Block Grant Application to the U.S. Department of Housing
6 and Urban Development.

7 WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended,
8 establishes a program of financial assistance to local governments for the de-
9 velopment of viable urban communities through the provision of decent housing
10 and a suitable living environment and expanded economic opportunities, primarily
11 for persons of low and moderate income; and,

12 WHEREAS, the Act provides that the three year Housing Assistance Plan and
13 Annual Housing Action Plans are the focus for mutual cooperation between local
14 jurisdictions and national HUD housing programs for carrying out locally deter-
15 mined housing strategies; and,

16 WHEREAS, King County is in a Consortium with twenty-six cities and towns;
17 and,

18 WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Committee has reviewed and approved the Annual
19 Housing Action Plan, required by federal law to be submitted as part of the Block
20 Grant application; and

21 WHEREAS, the Council had held public hearings to hear the views of citizens
22 on housing and community development needs; and

23 WHEREAS, the Annual Housing Action Plan incorporates by reference applicable
24 sections of the 1979-81 Housing Assistance Plan approved by the Council
25 February 20, 1979;

26 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

27 The 1981 Annual Housing Action Plan is adopted as part of the overall
28 Community Development Plan and Application.

29 BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

30 1. The Council of King County finds and determines that this Annual
31 Housing Action Plan reflects the needs and priorities for housing assistance
in King County and that it shall supersede the 1980 Annual Housing Action Plan

1 after adoption by the Council and approval by HUD.


2 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to submit the 1981
3 Annual Housing Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development
4 with the County's application for Housing and Community Development Block Grant
5 funds.

6 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to use this Annual Housing
7 Action Plan in reviewing and ranking projects proposed for federal housing
8 assistance under Section 213 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974,
9 as amended.


10 4. It is the County's intention that federal housing agencies comply with
11 both the spirit and the letter of the goals and priorities stated in this Housing
12 Action Plan when making program allocations and conducting other activities in
13 the County.
