

MOTION NO. 5193

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
2 submit a grant application of approximately  
3 \$1,886,850 to the Economic Development  
4 Administration for public works facilities  
5 construction in the Kenmore Business District  
6 Development Area.

7 WHEREAS, the Central Puget Sound Economic Development  
8 District provides funding support of job-creating public and  
9 private sector investments, and

10 WHEREAS, job stimulating projects are designed to serve  
11 target area populations, and

12 WHEREAS, King County is considering the adoption of a  
13 policy encouraging urban centers as the focal point for  
14 residential, commercial, retail and industrial expansion and  
15 development, and

16 WHEREAS, Census Tract 217 in the Kenmore Business District  
17 has been identified by the King County Housing & Community  
18 Development Division as a target area, and

19 WHEREAS, recent private investment has caused unforeseen  
20 pressure on public facilities such as water utilities and road  
21 networks, and

22 WHEREAS, the recent growth in this area causes additional  
23 traffic hazards on King County roads, (i.e. N.E. 181st Street  
24 between 68th Avenue N.E. and 73rd Avenue N.E., 68th Avenue N.E.  
25 between the Sammamish River and N.E. 185th Street, and N.E. 175th  
26 Street between 68th Avenue N.E. and 73rd Avenue N.E.), and

27 WHEREAS, increased traffic causes congestion and traffic  
28 hazards at the intersection of N.E. 181st Street and 68th Avenue  
29 N.E., and

30 WHEREAS, the above mentioned public facility improvements  
31 were itemized and identified in the Northshore Community Plan, and

32 WHEREAS, public investment in the Kenmore Business District  
33 will help reach the regional goals and strategies of the Economic  
Development Administration, Central Puget Sound Economic Develop-  
ment District and King County Subregional Council of the Puget  
Sound Council of Governments.

WHEREAS, energy demands are lessened when jobs are provided  
closer to home, and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties Steering  
Committee on Community Development approved a resolution urging  
the Reagan Administration to keep funding at present levels  
through fiscal year 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make  
application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,886,850 to  
the Economic Development Administration for the Kenmore Business  
District Redevelopment on behalf of King County;


2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file  
and execute such application and enter into and execute such  
contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter  
into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the  
implementation of the project;

4. The Economic Development Administration is/are hereby  
assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
