A MOTION of the King County Council, fixing the date, time, and place for a public hearing on the final assessment roll of Utility Local Improvement District No. 2 and on proposed Ordinance No. 81-104.

WHEREAS, there has been prepared the final assessment roll for Utility Local Improvement District No. 2 of King County and such final assessment roll has been filed with the County Council, and pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.94.250 it is necessary to fix the date, time and place of public hearing on such assessment roll and proposed Ordinance No. 81-104 approving and confirming that roll, and to give notice of the filing of such roll and such public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

SECTION 1. A public hearing on the final assessment roll of
Utility Local Improvement District No. 1 and on proposed
Ordinance No. 81-104 approving and confirming that roll shall be
held before the County Council at 9:30 A.m. (local time) on

April 27, 1981, in the Council Chambers, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of the County Council is hereby authorized and directed to cause to be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Utility Local Improvement District No. 2, the first publication to be at least fifteen days prior to the hearing date, a notice stating that the roll is on file and open to inspection in the office of the County Council and stating the time when the public hearing before the County Council will be held on such assessment roll, on the protests filed, and on Ordinance No. 81-104 approving and confirming that roll, and advising the property owners that protests must be filed with the Clerk of the County Council against any assessments shown on the roll at or prior to the time of such public hearing. Similar notices shall be mailed to the owners or
