MOTION NO. <u>5212</u>

A MOTION authorizing the King County Districting Committee to spend up to five thousand and five hundred dollars to retain the services of a districting master and rescinding Motion No. 5188.

WHEREAS, Section 650.30.20 of the King County Charter provides for the selection of a districting master by the Districting Committee, and

WHEREAS, in order to retain a districting master, defined by the Charter as "qualified by education, training, and experience," it is reasonable and necessary to expend funds, and

WHEREAS, the Districting Committee has recommended additional compensation to the master in excess of that authorized in Motion No. 5188 because the Committee required additional work from him;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. Motion No. 5188 is hereby rescinded.
- B. The Districting Committee is authorized to spend up to five thousand and five hundred dollars in 1981, plus a maximum of \$250.00 for expenses, to retain the services of a districting master.
