MOTION NO. 5249

A MOTION relating to the Housing and Community Development Block Grant and adopting an updated Three-Year Plan for Community Development 1982 -1984 for King County Block Grant Consortium.

WHEREAS, King County is a member of the Community Development Block Grant Consortium; and

WHEREAS, all members of the Community Development Block Grant Consortium are required to adopt a Three-Year Plan for Community Development; and

WHEREAS, King County has adopted the Three-Year Plan for Community Development 1981 - 1983 by Motion No. 4945; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Committee has approved the Block Grant Consortium Plan for Community Development 1981 - 1983 for King County; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development required that entitlement jurisdictions prepare a three-year strategy for community development funds; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development requires an updated plan to be prepared for the period 1982 - 84; and

WHEREAS, the King County Executive has submitted the updated Block Grant Consortium Three-Year Plan for Community Development 1982 - 84;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The attached updated Block Grant Consortium Three-Year Plan for Community Development 1982 - 84 is hereby adopted to amend the existing plan and to govern the planning process and development of the 1982 - 84 Community Development Program;

Provided that:

The section entitled "Program Management" (Page 11 of the Draft Plan) is amended to delete sub-paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 and substitute the following language:

 The status of Needs and Joint projects will be reviewed by the Joint Policy Committee six months after funds

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become available. Projects not yet begun may be reevaluated by the JPC for possible reduction or cancellation. Such determination will be made in the form of a recommendation to the King County Council in keeping with the Consortium's Cooperation Agreement. Any funds resulting from such Council action will revert to the fund from which they originated.

- 2. Needs and Joint projects which are not begun within the program year for which the funds were made available may be recommended by the JPC to the County Council for cancellation. Funds resulting from such Council action will revert to the fund from which they originated.
- B. The regional earmarks for the 1982 program year shall be computed using the formula that was used for the 1981 program year.
