## MOTION NO. <u>5278</u>

A MOTION authorizing the expenditure of funds reserved by Ordinance 5232 for a 911 program and other emergency services.

WHEREAS, the County Council allocated \$62,000 in Ordinance 5232, the 1981 budget ordinance, for implementation of a 911 program, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 5232 provided that the moneys could be expended only after the Council had given its authorization by Motion, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested that authorization in order to pay for studies of certain phases of a County-wide 911 program, and

WHEREAS, the Council will need information on a less-than-Countywide program in order to evaluate any proposal for a 911 program;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to expend
\$30,000 of the moneys allocated for implementation of a 911
program in Section 48 of Ordinance 5232, PROVIDED THAT:

A portion of the moneys is used to provide an independent cost study of a basic 911 program which covers all areas of the County except those presently served by a 911 program and which incorporates use of existing regional communications systems and the County's microwave capability as potential methods of reducing costs.

PROVIDED FURTHER THAT: An additional amount not to exceed \$1,000 per year is authorized for payment of gasoline and oil for
