A MOTION reaffirming Motion 5201 and stating Council intent with respect to future administration of the County's housing rehabilitation programs.

WHEREAS, the Council, in Motion 5201, adopted specific guidelines for restructuring the County's housing and community development program, including:

- o Housing assistance planning will remain a County responsibility, although the changing focus of the County's program will permit a reduction in the planning staff
- o A draft of the County's housing plans will be submitted to the Housing Authority of the County of King for its review and comment
- o Development of the Housing & Community Development Block Grant program and application will remain a County responsibility, and

WHEREAS, the Council, in Ordinance 5589, established that the County's Housing Repair and Weatherization Programs would be administered by the Housing Authority, pursuant to written agreements with the County;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- The guidelines stated in Motion 5201 regarding housing planning and the Block Grant program and application are hereby reaffirmed.
- В. In order to allow for an orderly transition, it is the Council's intent that the Housing Authority begin administering the Weatherization Program as of January 1, 1982. The Executive is hereby directed to negotiate all necessary agreements and contracts in a timely fashion so that the January 1, 1982, deadline can be achieved.

The Housing Authority when hiring persons to carry out its new responsibilities under Ordinance 5589, is hereby requested to give first preference to persons currently employed by the County in the County's housing rehabilitation program.
