A MOTION requesting the King County Noxious Weed Control Board to prepare a report on the status of the Tansy Ragwort problem.

WHEREAS, the King County Noxious Weed Control Board has been active and has received an annual operating appropriation from the Current Expense Fund, and

WHEREAS, the Noxious Weed Control Board has apparently observed the increase in infestation of the Tansy Ragwort Weed on lands in King County;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Noxious Weed Control Board is requested to prepare a status report on the damaging infestation of Tansy Ragwort Weed and to propose an efficient and effective program for controlling the problem. The report should include a financing plan for funding the proposed program.


