MOTION NO. <u>5296</u>

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Seattle for the resurfacing of North and Northeast 145th Street from Aurora Avenue North to Lake City Way Northeast in King County, and committing to an estimated expenditure of \$238,875 in 1981.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle is intending to resurface its portion of North and Northeast 145th Street from Aurora Avenue North to Lake City Way Northeast as a part of its "1980 Resurfacing Program," and

WHEREAS, King County is desirous of having its portion of North and Northeast 145th Street resurfaced, and it is in the best public interest to have the entire roadway resurfaced at one time under the same contract, and

WHEREAS, King County will reimburse the City of Seattle for such costs of resurfacing, engineering and such other work as may be necessary. Final payment by King County to the City of Seattle will be based upon actual contract costs incurred.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Seattle to commit King County's share of the project costs.
- 2. The King County Council confirms its committment to finance the County's share in the 1981 Annual Budget as adopted by Ordinance No. 5232 as amended.
