WHEREAS, approximately 2.7 million fires occur each year
in the United States, and

WHEREAS, approximately 8,400 deaths occur each year from
fires, and

WHEREAS, approximately 90,000 persons are injured each year
in fires, and

WHEREAS, approximately 5.3 billion dollars in property is
lost each year to fire, and

WHEREAS, the first week in October of each year is
nationally recognized as Fire Prevention Week, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes that fire
prevention awareness is the key to reducing fire losses, and


WHEREAS, the King County Council supports continued

saving lives;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
