A MOTION stating county policies regarding compliance with mandatory custodial care standards for new jail facilities.

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Chapter 276, Laws of 1981, requires that cities and counties receiving state funding for meeting physical plant standards for jails certify their intention that facilities built meet all mandatory custodial care standards upon opening:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to certify in accordance with Section 5 of Chapter 276, Laws of 1981, that King County will fully comply with all mandatory custodial care standards in the new jail facility which has been provided state funding at such time that facility opens to house prisoners.
