A MOTION relating to solid waste supporting the joint King County/Seattle Energy/Resource Recovery Implementation Project and commending the County Executive and the Mayor and Council of Seattle for their efforts of cooperation and coordination in this joint project.

WHEREAS, the King County Council in 1978 requested the County Executive to develop a plan to achieve a recommendation by December 1, 1981 for appropriate energy generation/resource recovery from solid wastes generated in King County by Motion 3581, and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 1979, King County and Seattle were approved by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to jointly submit a final grant application for a solid waste energy/resource recovery implementation project in King County, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council, by its Motion 4246 supported the Phase I joint application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency, and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 1979 the United States Environmental Protection Agency awarded grant funds for Phase I of the joint solid waste energy/resource recovery implementation project in King County, and

WHEREAS, the Phase I Report and Staff Analysis thereof have been completed and considered by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the Phase I Report finds that energy/resource recovery should be feasible in the King County area and recommends that the joint project proceed to Phase II, definitive feasibility and procurement planning, and

WHEREAS, the Council applauds and supports the County Executive's continued initiative and persistency in pursuing this cooperative implementation project, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council wishes to express its support and concern for the success of source separation and recycling in all of King County;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
