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## **AGREEMENT**

In consideration of the mutual covenant herein, King County (hereinafter called the "County"), and the City of Kent, (hereinafter called the "City") agree as follows:

- 1. The County shall deliver to the City in the ordinary course of business, \$69,523, which is a part of the general obligation bonds of the County, funded pursuant to Resolution 34571 of the County, and represents an amount of cash designated by the County to complete a neighborhood park pursuant to King County Resolution 34571, 3(E)(4).

The City shall hold such money in trust and shall faithfully apply the same to the purposes authorized in said Resolution 34571 and subsections noted above in the manner and subject to conditions provided in the said Resolution; shall operate, maintain all facilities acquired, constructed, developed and approved with said money; shall defend and save the County harmless from any claim or damage resulting from the acquisition, construction, development, operation, maintenance, improvement, repair, replacement or public use of such facilities and shall perform and comply with all conditions in
