WHEREAS, he has for more than 20 years given of his time as a volunteer swimming instructor for the Red Cross, and


WHEREAS, the beneficiaries of Julius Boehm's activities are the residents of King County, especially its young people;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


