## MOTION NO. 5384

A MOTION relating to a system of reimbursement for the Prosecuting Attorney and Assessor, for transportation.

WHEREAS, the King County Charter, Section 220.20 provides that the County Council shall establish the compensation to be paid to all County officers and employees and shall provide for the reimbursement of expenses, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.28 of the King County Code, provides that the County Council may establish a system of reimbursement for the use of privately owned vehicles used in connection with County business in lieu of permanently assigned County vehicles, and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the King County Council to seek to minimize the number of County-owned and operated vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The Prosecuting Attorney and the Assessor are expected to exercise prudent judgement in incurring reimbursable expenses on official County business. Excessive or unnecessary expenses shall not be approved or reimbursed.
- B. Reimbursable transportation expenses shall include the cost of all actual and necessary official travel on railroads, airlines, ships, buses, private and rental automobiles and other usual means of conveyance.
- C. Reimbursement for the use of privately owned vehicles in connection with County business shall be allowed at the current rate per mile prescribed by County ordinance. In lieu of such reimbursement, the Prosecuting Attorney and the Assessor may, at their individual option, be compensated on a monthly basis for the use of privately owned vehicles used in connection with County business. To implement this alternative, the Administrator of the Council shall periodically, and no less than annually, ascertain the average monthly costs to the Motor Pool for the

1		maintenance and operation of equivalent vehicles within the fleet
2		Ninety percent of that figure shall be the maximum allowable
3		compensation.
