

MOTION NO. 5427

2 A MOTION recognizing the need for  
3 additional financial support for the  
4 King County Law Library; and directing  
5 the Director of Judicial Administration  
6 to increase from seven to eight dollars  
7 the portion of certain filing fees paid  
8 to the credit of the Library as provided  
9 by RCW 27.24.070.

7 WHEREAS, the expenditures of the King County Law Library  
8 have exceeded income during calendar year 1981, and

9 WHEREAS, the expense of operating the Law Library increased  
10 13.4% in 1980, and 8.5% in 1981, and

11 WHEREAS, the present portion of the seventy dollar filing  
12 fee paid in Superior Court earmarked for the support of the  
13 King County Law Library is seven dollars, and

14 WHEREAS, the portion of the filing fee paid in Superior  
15 Court designated for the support of the King County Law Library  
16 has remained unchanged since May, 1979, and

17 WHEREAS RCW 27.24.070 provides that upon a showing of need,  
18 the seven dollar portion may be increased to nine dollars by the  
19 County Council upon the request of the Law Library Board of  
20 Trustees, and

21 WHEREAS, the King County Law Library Board of Trustees is  
22 requesting the County Council to increase the portion of the  
23 filing fee from seven to nine dollars as soon as possible,

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY the Council of King County:

25 1. The Director of the Department of Judicial Administration  
26 is directed to increase from seven to eight dollars the portion  
27 of the filing fee paid to the credit of the King County Law  
28 Library as provided by RCW 27.24.070.

29 2. Prior to the end of 1982, a review of the King County  
30 Law Library's financial status shall have occurred, with the

1 results of the review transmitted to the Chairman of the  
2 County Council.

3 3. Accompanying the transmittal to the Chairman of the  
4 Council shall be a recommendation to increase the portion of  
5 the filing fee from eight to nine dollars, should the financial  
6 situation warrant such an increase.
