

MOTION NO. 5431

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2 A MOTION to set the date of a hearing upon  
3 the Final Assessment Roll for Road Improvement  
4 District No. 90 for street lights in the plat  
of Covington Firs

5 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 5124 created King County  
6 Road Improvement District No. 90 for erection of ornamental street  
7 lights on the streets within the plat of Covington Firs. The  
8 installation has been completed and the cost is now known, and

9 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 5124 directed the Director  
10 of the Department of Public Works & Transportation, upon comple-  
11 tion of the installation of the street lights, to prepare and file  
12 with the King County Council Clerk, a Final Assessment Roll for  
13 the final assessment to be levied against the property included in  
14 Road Improvement District No. 90. The Final Assessment Roll has  
15 been prepared and filed with the Clerk of the King County Council;

16 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

17 A. Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.88.090, the hearing  
18 upon the Final Assessment Roll for King County Road Improvement  
19 District No. 90 shall be scheduled for April 12, 1982, at  
20 9:30 a.m.

21 B. The King County Council will sit as a board of equaliza-  
22 tion for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment roll at  
23 aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such objections as  
24 are made thereto or any part thereof, and will correct, revise,  
25 raise, lower, change or modify said rolls or any part thereof, or  
26 set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made de novo,  
27 as to such body shall appear just and equitable, and then proceed  
28 to confirm the same by ordinance.

29 C. The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed  
30 to give notice of hearing upon said roll to all owners or reputed  
31 owners of the property whose name appears thereon by making a  
32 notice thereof at least fifteen (15) days before the date fixed  
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1 for the hearing to such owners or reputed owners at the address  
 2 of such as shown on the tax rolls of the County Comptroller; in  
 3 addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two  
 4 times in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Such  
 5 notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll  
 6 and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to  
 7 make such objections in writing and to file same with the Clerk of  
 8 the Council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
