MOTION NO. 5432

A MOTION directing the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to consider the North Soos Creek Plateau Study in all subdivision, reclassification, and planned unit development applications located in the North Soos Creek Plateau Study area; requesting the King County Division of Planning and Community Development to review the North Soos Creek Plateau Study and to prepare a study to determine the need to revise the Soos Creek Community Plan pursuant to Ordinance 4305.

WHEREAS, Motion 5354 requested the Department of Planning and Community Development to prepare a comprehensive study examining the schedules and priorities for the completion of public improvements designed to accommodate development mandated by the Soos Creek Community Plan for that portion of the Lakes subarea shown on Attachment A to determine if such schedules and priorities are still valid and to recommend what, if any, changes in the timing of public facilities or new private development implementation within the Lakes subarea should be made, and

WHEREAS, the North Soos Creek Plateau Study (December 1981) was transmitted for Council consideration on January 22, 1982, and

WHEREAS, the North Soos Creek Plateau Study evaluates a larger area than that identified in Motion 5354 which contributes traffic to the arterial system serving the North Soos Creek Plateau Study area, and

WHEREAS, the North Soos Creek Plateau Study directly relates to the subject of transportation planning in the Soos Creek Community Plan adopted by the Council in November 1979, and

WHEREAS, the North Soos Creek Plateau Study has yet to be formally studied or adopted by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that traffic and congestion in the Soos Creek Plateau Community Plan area is an issue of important concern to area residents and in King County,




NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. County processing of new development applications filed after the date of this motion for developments located within the North Soos Creek Plateau Study area (attachment B) shall include consideration of the North Soos Creek Plateau Study. The Zoning and Subdivision Examiner shall allow for such written or oral testimony the Examiner deems necessary. The Examiner's consideration of the study shall include a review of the application's relationship to the problems identified in the study. Additional information may be submitted to the Examiner which addresses additional improvements or changes in conditions that may have occurred since the study was completed.
- B. The County Council's Planning and Community Development Committee shall discuss, review, and consider alternative solutions for funding and timing of public facilities, as well as strategies for managing the facilities to the fullest extent and methods for alerting the County when improvements are needed. The Committee shall recommend to the County Council by June 1, 1982, methods to address the transportation problems illustrated by the study.
- C. The County Executive is requested to provide the necessary staff to work with the Committee in reviewing this issue and preparing recommendations for consideration by the Council and Executive.
- D. The Council requests the King County Department of Planning and Community Development to solicit public comment on the North Soos Creek Plateau Study, to undertake a review of the North Soos Creek Plateau Study, and, pursuant to section 5 of Ordinance 4305, to prepare a study to determine the need for revision of the Soos Creek Community Plan, in light of (a) information contained in the North Soos Creek Plateau Study, (b)
