2 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive  
3 to enter into an agreement with the U. S. Soil  
4 Conservation Service related to the installation  
5 and maintenance of landscape plantings along the  
6 Black River Outlet Channel; part of the East  
7 Side Green River Watershed Project.

8 WHEREAS, King County, the Green River Flood Control Zone  
9 District, the Cities of Renton, Tukwila, Kent and Auburn, and  
10 the King County Conservation District are local sponsors of the  
11 East Side Green River Watershed Project, planned by the Soil  
12 Conservation Service under Public Law 566; and

13 WHEREAS, King County is the agent designated by the other  
14 sponsors and so accepted under terms of King County Resolution  
15 33605, for liaison with the Soil Conservation Service; and

16 WHEREAS, the Soil Conservation Service has prepared plans  
17 and specifications for the planting of trees and shrubs for  
18 landscaping and wildlife habitat along the Black River Outlet  
19 Channel improvement, constructed in 1981 under agreements with  
20 the Soil Conservation Service authorized by King County Motion  
21 No. 4850; and

22 WHEREAS, the planting of trees and shrubs is in accordance  
23 with the Environmental Mitigation Program accepted for all the  
24 local sponsors by resolution dated October 21, 1980, of the  
25 Green River Basin Executive Committee, established under terms  
26 of King County Motion No. 3787; and

27 WHEREAS, the planting also is in accordance with the Soil  
28 Conservation Service Watershed Work Plan for the East Side Green  
29 River Watershed Project which has been approved by King County  
30 Motion No. 4707; and

31 WHEREAS, the Soil Conservation Service requires that prior  
32 to installation, the local sponsors sign a Project Agreement  
33 assuming responsibility for operation and maintenance in  
accordance with the Operation and Maintenance Agreement; with  
all installation costs to be funded by the Federal Government;

1 and,

2 WHEREAS, the Operation and Maintenance Agreement referred  
3 to in the proposed Project Agreement has been stated by the  
4 Soil Conservation Service to be the same Operation and  
5 Maintenance Agreement previously authorized by Motion No. 4850:

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

7 The King County Executive is authorized to enter into and  
8 carry out the provisions of a Project Agreement with the Soil  
9 Conservation Service in substantially the form as attached  
10 hereto, related to the installation and maintenance of  
11 landscape plantings along the Black River Outlet Channel; part  
12 of the East Side Green River Watershed Project.

13 PROVIDED THAT:

14 operation and maintenance costs incurred by King County are  
15 eligible for reimbursement from revenues generated by the  
16 financial program established to fund the East Side Watershed  
17 Project.
