A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make grant applications for specific solid waste facility capital improvement projects: Rural Landfill Upgrade, Hobart Landfill Leachate Control, and Vashon Landfill Leachate Control.

WHEREAS, the King County Council by its Ordinance No. 5694, dated September 21, 1981, authorized the issuance and sale of Councilmanic Bonds for various capital projects, including solid waste facility capital projects, and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1981 bids were opened and low bid was accepted for issuance and sale of Councilmanic Bonds for various capital projects, including solid waste facility capital projects, and

WHEREAS, grant monies may be available from the Washington State Department of Ecology to help support the cost of the solid waste facility capital projects referred to in Ordinance No. 5694;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Executive is authorized and encouraged to apply for all grant monies available from the Washington State Department of Ecology to help support the cost of solid waste facility capital projects referred to in Ordinance No. 5694, and listed below:

1. Rural Landfill Upgrade, 1982 C.I.P. Budget Project No. 3063; and
2. Hobart Landfill Leachate Control, 1982 C.I.P. Budget Project No. 3062; and
3. Vashon Landfill Leachate Control, 1982 C.I.P. Budget Project No. 3065.
