2 A MOTION to set the date for a hearing upon
3 the Maintenance Assessment Roll for Road
4 Improvement District No. 87 for Street Lights
5 in the plat of Meadow Hills

6 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 4671 created King County
7 Road Improvement District No. 87 for maintaining, energizing and
8 operating street lights in the plat of Meadow Hills: The
9 improvement has been completed and the cost is now known, and

10 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 4671 directed the
11 Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation to
12 prepare and file with the King County Council Clerk, a
13 Maintenance Assessment Roll for the maintenance assessment to be
14 levied against the property included in Road Improvement District
15 No. 87: The Maintenance Assessment Roll has been prepared and
16 filed with the Clerk of the King County Council;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 A. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090,
19 the hearing upon the Maintenance Assessment Roll for King County
20 Road Improvement District No. 87 shall be scheduled for
21 June 14, 1982, at 9:30 a.m.

22 B. The King County Council will sit as a board of
23 equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment
24 roll at aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such
25 objections as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will
26 correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said rolls or any
27 part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such
28 assessment be made de novo, as to such body shall appear just and
29 equitable, and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

30 C. The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed
31 to give notice of hearing upon said roll to all owners or
32 reputed owners of the property whose name appears thereon by
33 mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen (15) days before the
date fixed for the hearing to such owners or reputed owners at

1 the address of such as shown on the tax rolls of the County
2 Comptroller; in addition thereto, such notices shall be published
3 at least two (2) times in a newspaper of general circulation in
4 the County. Such notices shall specify the time and place of
5 hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire
6 to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file
7 same with the Clerk of the Council at or prior to the date fixed
8 for said hearing.
