2 A MOTION setting the date of hearing on the  
3 Reassessment and to reconsider the Assessment  
4 Roll for King County Road Improvement District  
No. 69.

5 WHEREAS, King County Road Improvement District No. 69 ("RID  
6 69") was established by King County Ordinance No. 2510 passed by  
7 the King County Council on October 6, 1975, to provide for the  
8 installation of underground electric and street lighting  
9 facilities in the Sheridan #5 area; and

10 WHEREAS, the original assessment roll for RID 69 was con-  
11 firmed by King County Ordinance No. 4995 passed by the King County  
12 Council on July 14, 1980, after construction of the improvement  
13 project had been completed, and after a public hearing on March  
14 31, 1980 for the purpose of considering the assessment roll; and

15 WHEREAS, certain statutes of the State of Washington in  
16 effect at the time of the creation of RID 69 limited the interest  
17 rate which could lawfully be levied on RID assessments and made it  
18 impracticable to issue and sell revenue bonds to finance said  
19 improvements, and such statutes have been amended; and

20 WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works has  
21 prepared and filed with the Clerk of the Council an assessment  
22 roll setting forth that portion of the total costs and expenses of  
23 accomplishing the improvement project which are to be reassessed  
24 against the property within RID 69, and the amount to be assessed  
25 against each parcel therein;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

27 A. The Council hereby states its intention to hold a  
28 public hearing pursuant to RCW 36.88.090 for the purpose of  
29 reconsidering the revised assessment roll for RID 69 which is on  
30 file with the Clerk of the Council. Said hearing is scheduled  
31 for July 19, 1982, 1982, at 9:30 a.m.

At the hearing, the Council will sit as a board of equalization for the purpose of reconsidering the assessment roll, and will consider such written objections as are made thereto, or any part thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change, or modify the roll or any part thereof. Or, the Council may set aside said roll and make the assessments de novo so that they are just and equitable, and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

C. The Clerk of the Council is hereby directed to give notice of the public hearing by mailing and publication at the times and in the manner set forth in RCW 36.88.090, in accordance with RCW 36.88.100 and 35.44.350.
