WHEREAS, the Federal Way Hospital Implementation Committee is the successor to the community-based planning committee which guided the study, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Way Hospital Implementation Committee is also broadly representative of community interests, and

WHEREAS, the Implementation Committee has endorsed the concept of a full-service hospital developed in conjunction with a "health care campus" where ancillary medical services and community education in the prevention of illness can be provided, and

WHEREAS, this concept is unique and worthy of support;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Council hereby endorses the efforts of the Federal Way Hospital Implementation Committee to provide a full-service hospital in the Federal Way area.
