

MOTION NO. 5490 Proposed No. 82-335

A MOTION recognizing July 11 - 17,
1982 as Asian Refugee Week in King County.

WHEREAS, there are now 19,000 Southeast Asian Refugees
who have chosen to make King County their new home; and

WHEREAS, the cutbacks in Federal and state funding to help
these refugees resettle in their new homeland have led to
critical financial problems for many of these refugees; and

WHEREAS, many of King County's Asian community service
organizations have responded to the financial crises of the
refugees by sponsoring a special series of fundraising events, the
first of which is to be held July 16th at the Seattle Paramount
Theater;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council hereby recognizes the week of July
11 - 17, 1982 as Asian Refugee Week in King County and invites
all citizens of King County to support Asian Refugee Week by
attending some of the fundraising events.
