

## MOTION NO. 5516

1 A MOTION confirming the King County's Executive's appoint-  
2 ment of Eugene G. Duvernoy as Director, Office of  
Agriculture.

3 WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 5559, Section 6, Eugene G. Duvernoy has  
4 submitted to the King County Council Chairman:

5 (1) A full and complete resume of his employment history; and

6 (2) A signed statement acknowledging that the Council's confirmation  
7 process may require the submittal of additional information relating to his  
8 background and expertise; and

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 5559, Section 5, Eugene G. Duvernoy  
10 fully meets the following evaluation criteria:

11 (1) A demonstrated reputation for integrity and professionalism;

12 (2) A commitment to and knowledge of the responsibilities of the office;

13 (3) A history of demonstrated leadership experience and administrative  
14 ability;

15 (4) The ability to work effectively with the Executive, the Council,  
16 other management, public agencies, private organizations, and citizens; and

17 (5) A demonstrated sensitivity to and knowledge of the particular needs  
18 and problems of minorities and women; and

19 WHEREAS, pursuant to King County Code, Section 3.04.050, Eugene G.  
20 Duvernoy filed a Financial Disclosure Statement with the King County Board of  
21 Ethics;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

23 The King County Executive's appointment of Eugene G. Duvernoy as  
24 Director, Office of Agriculture is confirmed.
