

MOTION NO. 5533

A MOTION concurring with the King county Executive's allocation of \$18,000 of the historic preservation block grant funds for the James W. Clise Mansion at Marymoor Park. The historic preservation block grant funds were previously appropriated under the 1979 Housing & Community Development Block Grant Program.

WHEREAS, THE King County Council has, through Ordinance 2991, and Ordinance 4828, adopted the goal of preserving and selectively encouraging the restoration of buildings, sites and areas that depict the evolution of King County, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 4112, authorized the expenditure of \$59,000 in 1979 Housing & Community Block Grant Funds for historic preservation projects, and

WHEREAS, the King County Landmarks Commission has named the James W. Clise Mansion the first King County Landmark and has identified it as one of the highest priority for County grant assistance, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 5757, adopted the proviso that the Landmarks Commission give priority to funding improvements to the James W. Clise Mansion, and

WHEREAS, the King County Parks and Recreation Division is partially allocating funds to this restoration project, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive has reviewed and concurs with the above recommendations;
