MOTION NO. 5536

A MOTION making findings regarding a plan revision for an area in the vicinity of NE 124th Street and I-405 and requesting the Planning Division to prepare plan revision documents and adopting ordinance.

WHEREAS, The Department of Planning and Community Development has prepared a study to determine the need to revise the Revised Northshore Community Plan for property in the vicinity of NE 124th St. and I-405, and

WHEREAS, the study was requested by the Council on February 1, 1982 prior to taking action on the reclassification request by Michael Boushee (BALD File No. (138-81-R), and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that substantial and material changed circumstances are caused by the Deutsch reclassification request (BALD File No. 118-82-R) approved by Council Ordinance 6019, which would allow construction of a motel/restaurant complex approximately 300 feet east of the Boushee property, and the impacts of Northshore Revision Issue J-3 which allows for motel/restaurant facilities in the vicinity of the interchange, and

WHEREAS, an area to the south of NE 124th was studied by the Planning Division, and

WHEREAS, this area is impacted by traffic circulation and drainage problems, and

WHEREAS, these problems were not adequately addressed in the Northshore Plan Revision, and

WHEREAS, development of lands in this area without a comprehensive plan review of these issues is not in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council finds that circumstances affecting the area of reclassification proposed by Michael Boushee (BALD File No. 138-81-R) have undergone substantial and material changes, and that a revision to RM-1800-P is appropriate pursuant to KCC 20.12.050-.080.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED

The Council requests the Planning Division to prepare plan revision documents and an adopting ordinance to amend Ordinance 5534 consistent with approving RM-1800-P on the Boushee property.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

The Council finds that drainage and traffic issues in the area south of NE 124th Street as identified in Figure 1 of the Planning Division Report are issues of current concern to the county that were not adequately addressed in the Northshore Community plan and its revision.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

The Planning Division is requested to prepare a community plan revision for the area in Figure 1 located south of NE 124th Street to address drainage and traffic circulation issues.
