WHEREAS, the County of King has applied for and received FAUS funding for the design of the signal at Northeast 124th Street and 132nd Avenue Northeast including approaches, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of all parties to coordinate the design of the Northeast 124th Street and 132nd Avenue Northeast intersection and to complete the segment from 128th Northeast to 132nd Northeast, thus providing a complete facility;
