2 A MOTION authorizing the establishment of the
3 position title of "Corporal" in the Division of
4 Corrections, Department of Rehabilitative Services.

5 WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 6003 the King County Council required,
6 "substantiation for the recommendation of the new job function of Corporal,"
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Rehabilitative Services and the Division
9 of Personnel have developed a set of procedures and guidelines for the
10 selection, assignment and duties of the position of Corporal, and

11 WHEREAS, it is specified that the position title of Correctional Corporal
12 is a working title and assignment to the position of Corporal is effective
13 only for the period during which a Corrections Officer is assigned the duties
14 specified in the standard operating procedures; and

15 WHEREAS, persons retain the permanent rank of Corrections Officer while
16 assigned to the position of Corporal, without effect on the allowance for
17 Corrections Officers; and

18 WHEREAS, the County Council has reviewed the procedures, guidelines
19 and duties of the Corporal position and find it acceptable as an assignment
20 in the Division of Corrections, Department of Rehabilitative Services.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 A. The assignment of the position of Corporal in the Division of
23 Corrections, Department of Rehabilitative Services is acknowledged as
24 appropriate.

25 B. The Director, Department of Rehabilitative Services, is hereby
26 authorized to assign individuals to the job function of Corporal in the
27 Division of Corrections, Department of Rehabilitative Services as outlined
28 in the standard operating procedures in the Division of Corrections, Department
29 of Rehabilitative Services. The number of assignments to the position of
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1 Corporal will be subject to management analysis of needs and budgetary
2 constraints.
