Social and Health Services for Referendum 37 consideration.

- A. Addition for Residential Facility for Mentally Ill proposed by Transitional Resources for Young Adults for \$86,340.
- B. Alcohol Transition House Sobriety House proposed by the King County Division of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services for \$1,100,000.
- C. Construction of a Developmental Disability Training
 Center to provide pre-vocational as well as social and living
 skills for retarded adults as proposed by the South King County
 Activity Center for \$789,353.
 - D. Construction of a building to serve as the base for
