A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into Interlocal Agreements with various cities in King County for the purpose of establishing filing fees for certain criminal and traffic cases filed by such cities in district courts.

WHEREAS, RCW 3.62.070, as amended by Chapter 129, Laws of 1979, 1st Ex. Sess., and by Chapter 128, Laws of 1980, 1st Reg. Sess., requires King County and various cities in King County to enter into Interlocal Agreements for the purpose of establishing a filing fee to be paid in certain criminal and traffic infraction actions filed in district court for ordinance violations, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to existing Interlocal Agreements, King County and these various cities are desirous of establishing a filing fee in such cases at a mutually acceptable rate prior to the termination date of January 1, 1983 of existing Interlocal Agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into Interlocal Agreements with cities pursuant to RCW 3.62.070, as amended by Chapter 129, Laws of 1979, 1st Ex. Sess., and by Chapter 128, Laws of 1980, 1st Reg. Sess., to establish filing fees for certain criminal and traffic infraction actions filed by such cities in King County district courts for ordinance violations;

PROVIDED, the Executive consider the following formula in developing the filing fee rates:

- Projected annual operating costs per court based on current adopted budgets; less
- Personnel costs of the total number of judges and administrative clerks presently authorized per court; multiplied by

- C. The percentage difference between projected municipal filings and total filings per court for the current year; to which shall be added
- D. Personnel costs of the appropriate number of judges and administrative clerks per court based on municipal population alone, as per RCW 3.34.020; the sum of which shall be divided by
- E. The projected total number of municipal filings per court for the current year.

PROVIDED FURTHER, the rates proposed to be changed for the calendar year beginning January 1, 1984 shall also include all relevant costs associated with facilities capitalization costs, central administration and, expenses incurred as a result of the use of the county's probation program. PROVIDED FURTHER THAT, the rates proposed shall be forwarded to the Council for its review and approval by July 1, 1983.
