A MOTION requesting the Department of Health & Human Services to grant an extension of Program Year I to continue operation of the Head Start Program through January 31, 1983.

WHEREAS, the Federal Department of Health and Human Services has awarded a grant to King County to provide a Head Start Program for Program Year I, which ends October 31, 1982, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive transmitted a Motion which would have authorized a grant application to provide a Head Start Program for Program Year J (November 1, 1982, through October 31, 1983), and

WHEREAS, the County Executive transmitted his proposed 1983 budget which anticipates that the Head Start Program "will receive funding directly from the federal government," and

WHEREAS, King County, in cooperation with its Head Start partners, the City of Seattle, the Policy Council, and the Delegates Agencies, is considering various structural arrangements which would affect the Program Year J application, and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that funds be provided to continue operation of the Head Start Program while structural arrangements are being evaluated;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The grant application submitted by the County Executive for

Program Year J of the Head Start Program is hereby adopted, with

the condition that budget and programmatic changes approved by the King County Council will be forwarded to the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services by January 31, 1983.
