A MOTION calling on President Reagan to secure the release of Kevin Ellis and Brett Baldwin from captors in Zimbabwe, Africa.

WHEREAS, Kevin Ellis and Brett Baldwin were abducted by guerillas in Zimbabwe, Africa on July 23, 1982, and

WHEREAS, Kevin Ellis and his family are long-time residents of the City of Medina located in the Seattle/Bellevue/King County metropolitan area in the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, Kevin Ellis attended Bellevue schools, graduating from Bellevue High School, and both Kevin and Brett Baldwin recently graduated from the University of Washington, and

WHEREAS, Kevin Ellis and Brett Baldwin did not in any manner provoke their abduction, having visited Zimbabwe as tourists on an African safari, and

WHEREAS, Kevin Ellis and Brett Baldwin have been held hostage without communication for more than three months, and

WHEREAS, thousands of telegrams, letters, and petitions from concerned citizens throughout the United States have been sent to President Reagan and to the Department of State, urging that all potential diplomatic avenues be pursued, including a personal appeal from the President, to obtain the safe release of Kevin Ellis and Brett Baldwin, and

WHEREAS, actions taken by the Department of State and the Diplomatic Corps to free these United States citizens being held hostage have to this date been unsuccessful.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council calls on President Reagan and the Department of State to undertake the strongest possible diplomatic efforts to secure the safe release of Kevin Ellis and Brett Baldwin.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

The King County Council calls on the President and the Department of State to report in full to the families of the hostages and to members of the Washington State Congressional delegation the status of actions to achieve the release of these United States citizens held hostage.
