## MOTION NO. 5604

A MOTION remanding to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner the application by King County for an unclassified use permit for a solid waste transfer station, known as the Northshore Transfer Station, designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 152-79-U.

WHEREAS, on August 26, 1982 the King County Superior Court, in Cause No. 80-2-08830-1, remanded to King County the application made by King County for an unclassified use permit for a solid waste transfer station, designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 152-79-U, and

WHEREAS, the order of remand requires additional findings by the Council, for which the Council desires to receive the recommendations of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The Zoning and Subdivision Examiner is directed to review the record established in the public hearing previously conducted on the subject application, and determine:
- 1. Whether the conditions imposed upon the subject application can be identified by a specific document and page number in the environmental documents produced in accordance with the State Environmental Act; and
- 2. Whether or not the environmental impact statement submitted in this matter is adequate.
- B. The Zoning and Subdivision Examiner is authorized, if he deems it reasonable and necessary to do so: to reopen the public hearing on the subject matter for the introduction of supplemental environmental documents or other additional evidence; and to allow additional written or oral argument by any party.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

If the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner determines that the environmental impact statement prepared for this action was not adequate, the examiner
