A MOTION relating to Head Start and stating the County's intent to submit a plan and application to continue as the grantee, subject to certain conditions.

WHEREAS, Motion 5592 authorized submittal of a grant application for Program Year J of the Head Start Program on the condition "that budget and programmatic changes approved by the King County Council will be forwarded to the U. S. Department of Health & Human Services by January 31, 1983," and

WHEREAS, the intent of Motion 5592, as well as subsequent conditions placed by the Department of Health & Human Services on its grant award for Program Year J, was to resolve certain organizational problems which have been identified within the Head Start Program, including the County's future role, and

WHEREAS, resolution of those problems requires clarification from the Department as to how the Head Start Program can be absorbed into the County organizational structure, given the County's Charter and State law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council hereby states its intent that the County will submit an amendment incorporating structural and programmatic changes to the Program Year J grant application with the County as grantee; Provided That apparent conflicts between local and state law and Federal Head Start Regulations on the following points can be resolved by actions of the Department or otherwise:
