

MOTION NO. 5646

A MOTION appointing two fire commissioners for Fire Protection District No. 5 in King County, Washington.

WHEREAS, there are three fire commissioner positions for Fire Protection District No. 5, located in the Shoreline area of North King County, and

WHEREAS, the three commissioner positions are currently vacant, and

WHEREAS, RCW 52.12.050 prescribes the procedure for filling such vacancies, and

WHEREAS, in the event that a majority of a district's fire commissioner positions are vacant, state law directs the County legislative authority to appoint a sufficient number of commissioners as to constitute a majority, and

WHEREAS, the County Council having appointed persons to two of the three vacant commissioner positions, the remaining commissioner vacancy shall be filled by a vote of the two appointed fire commissioners, and

WHEREAS, according to the County's Division of Records and Elections, the three commissioner positions currently have stated terms of offices ending January 1984, 1986, and 1988, respectively, and

WHEREAS, per RCW 52.12.050, it is understood that all persons appointed to the positions shall stand for election at the next general election, to serve the remainder of the unexpired terms.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The following are appointed as fire commissioners for Fire Protection District No. 5 in King County, Washington:


- 1. Mr. Carlyle Cole, a term of office to expire January, 1986.
- 2. Mr. Clinton McMahan, a term of office to expire January, 1988.
- 3. The appointed commissioners shall appoint a third commissioner to serve a term of office, to expire January, 1984.
