A MOTION of the County Council of King County authorizing the County to enter into a Placement Agency Agreement for short term tax anticipation financing with Citibank, N.A.

WHEREAS, the County anticipates that during certain periods of 1983 its current expense fund will experience temporary shortages of cash to meet current expenses pending the receipt of taxes and therefore must borrow to meet those temporary shortages; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 216, Laws of 1982 of the State of Washington and the Charter and ordinances of King County permit the County to negotiate the sale of short term tax anticipation obligations to obtain the funds to meet such temporary shortages; and

WHEREAS, the County Council is of the belief that it is in the best interest of the County to enter into an agreement with Citibank, N.A., to sell and place short term "Commercial Paper Notes" of the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Agreement with Citibank, N.A., substantially in the form of the Agreement attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, but no Commercial Paper Notes or other obligations shall be issued under that Placement Agency Agreement until the same is authorized by ordinance of the County.
