MOTION NO. 5709

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the amount of \$50,000 to enhance the County's Minority Business Program, Grant File No. 306.

WHEREAS, the Minority Business Development Agency, U.S. Department of Commerce, is empowered to make grants to support increased minority business participation in local government contracting, and

WHEREAS, additional funding would help provide the necessary technical assistance to enhance our Minority Business Program, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that King County will be obligated to provide \$12,500 as an in-kind contribution in support of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$50,000 for its Minority Business Program to the Minority Business Development Agency, U.S. Department of Commerce, on behalf of King County;


B. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

C. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;


D. The Minority Business Development Agency, U.S. Department of Commerce, is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
