MOTION NO. <u>5746</u>

A MOTION relating to the Community Development Block Grant Program adopting Regional Earmarks for the 1984 program year.

WHEREAS, the Federal Government through adoption and administration of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, will make funds available to the King County Block Grant Consortium for expenditure during the 1984 program year, and

WHEREAS, King County receives a certain percentage of Community Development Block Grant Funds through the 1982-84 Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium, and

WHEREAS, King County annually adopts a formula for the distribution of King County "Population" funds in the four designated regions of King County: North, East, Southeast, and Southwest; and Countywide, and

WHEREAS, in 1981 the King County Council requested the formula for the distribution of King County "Population" funds be updated using 1980 United States Census data, and

WHEREAS, the 1980 United States Census data became available in 1983 to develop a new distribution formula for the 1984 program year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The Regional Earmarks for the 1984 program year shall be computed as follows:
- 1. County "Population" funds shall be 15 percent of available King County "Population" funds.
- 2. The remaining King County "Population" funds shall be allocated to regions according to a formula using factors from the 1980 United States Census where those factors are:
- a. Families with incomes below 80 percent of King County median income
 - b. Elderly population
 - c. Families below poverty level '
 - d. Non-families over age 64 below poverty level
 - e. Housing built before 1940.

- 3. The formula shall weight the total of Factor 1 and Factor 2 at 10 percent, the total of Factor 3 and Factor 4 at 50 percent, and Factor 5 at 40 percent. The formula shall be applied to the factors by region producing a composite regional factor. The regional factors shall be totaled and each regional factor computed as a percentage of the total. The percentage for each region shall be applied to that portion of County "Population" funds available for distribution to regions.
- 4. The percentage of County "Population" funds for each region and Countywide in 1984 shall be as follows:

North	23.1%
East	4.4%
Southeast	20.5%
Southwest	37.0%
Countywide	15.0%
	100.0%

B. The Regional Earmarks Formula and resulting Regional Earmarks for the 1984 program year are hereby adopted.
