at the Sammamish River Valley Park.

A MOTION authorizing an exchange of lands

WHEREAS, King County owns certain lands situated in King County, State of

WHEREAS, King County owns certain lands situated in King County, State of Washington, known as a portion of the Sammamish River Valley Park, and

WHEREAS, King County has been requested to convey lands to the City of Redmond for right of way to construct the N.E. 85th Street Bridge crossing the Sammamish River, and the Sammamish River Valley Park, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is making application for a direct grant of funds from the United States Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration (EDA) in order to defray costs of the Local Improvement District assessments associated with the N.E. 85th Street bridge construction project, and

WHEREAS, the construction of the N.E. 85th Street bridge will generate long term jobs in a time of high unemployment, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has determined that it is essential and in the best interests of the citizens of the State of Washington to acquire the necessary lands or property rights and rights in the property hereinafter more particularly set forth as TRACT X for the construction of the N.E. 85th Street bridge, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of King County to cooperate with the City of Redmond in the construction of the N.E. 85th Street bridge, so long as such construction does not adversely affect the use and development of the Sammammish Valley River Park, and

WHEREAS, the Sammamish River Valley Park is funded by the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation and therefore is subject to land use restrictions as provided for in Project Agreement No. 70-008-A, and as more particularly set forth in R.C.W. 43.99.100 whether or not the lands funded were marine recreation land. R.C.W. 43.99.100 reads as follows:

"Marine recreation land with respect to which money has been explained under R.C.W. 43.99.080 shall not, without the approval of the committee, be converted to uses other than those for which such expenditure was originally approved. The committee shall only approve any such conversion upon conditions which will assure the substitution of other marine recreation land of at least equal fair market value at the time of conversion and of nearly as feasible equivalent usefulness and location.";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into the appropriate agreements in order to facilitate the construction of the N.E. 85th Street bridge by the City of Redmond, providing that all plans and specifications are approved by King County and the appropriate governmental agencies having jurisdiction. The King County Executive is further authorized to convey any rights in the lands described herein necessary for the construction of the N.E. 85th Street bridge in accordance with terms and conditions acceptable to King County, and as may be imposed by Sammamish River Park Stage IV Project Agreement No. 70-008-A dated September 9, 1970, and R.C.W. 43.99.100.

TRACT X

A portion of land situated in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington, having a uniform width of 80 feet, 40 feet on each side of the following described centerline;

Commencing at the intersection of 158th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 85th Street; thence North 88°10'56" West for a distance of 350.57 feet to the true point of beginning; thence continuing North 88°10'56" West for a distance of 100 feet to the East margin of the Sammamish River channel (Drainage District No. 3) and the terminus of said centerline.

ALSO,

A portion of land situated in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington, having a uniform width of 80 feet, 40 feet on each side of the following described centerline; commencing at the Southwest corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 2; thence South 88°11'10" East for a distance of 1151.17 feet to the true point of beginning; thence continuing South 88°11'10" East for a distance of 100 feet to the West margin of the Sammamish River channel (Drainage District No. 3) and the terminus of said centerline.

Prior to the execution of any agreements with the City of Redmond to accomplish the exchange of lands at the Sammamish Valley Park, the City shall 1) provide King County with a written agreement exempting the County from any and all assessments

related to the proposed L.I.D. 2) demonstrate compliance with the requirements established by the Parks Division and Surface Water Management Division in the May 11, 1981 memorandum from the County's Department of Planning and Community Development to Frank Hansche, P.E. Redmond Public Works Director, as well as additional requirements deemed necessary by the County to mitigate potential adverse impacts on the Sammamish River Park.
