5 A MOTION relating to the Community  
6 Development Block Grant 1983 Federal  
7 Emergency Jobs Bill authorizing the  
8 County Executive to transfer project  
9 funds.

10 Whereas, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974,  
11 as amended, establishes a program of financial assistance to  
12 local governments for the development of viable communities  
13 through the provision of decent housing, a suitable living  
14 environment and expanded economic opportunities, primarily for  
15 persons of low and moderate income, and

16 Whereas, King County has qualified as an eligible urban  
17 county applicant for Block Grant funding under the Federal  
18 Emergency Jobs Bill, and

19 Whereas, on June 27, 1983 the County Council adopted  
20 Ordinance #6454 listing projects that were approved for  
21 Emergency Jobs Bill funding, and

22 Whereas, South King County Emergency Housing was deleted  
23 from the Proposed Ordinance, and

24 Whereas, Federal Way Boys and Girls Club was added to the  
25 list of projects, and

26 Whereas, a determination has not been made whether Federal  
27 Way Boys and Girls Club is eligible for Block Grant funding.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. Eligibility for funding of the Federal Way Boys and Girls Club should be determined by September 1, 1983.

B. If the Federal Way Boys and Girls Club is ineligible for Block Grant Emergency Jobs Bill funding, the County Executive is hereby authorized to transfer the funds to the South King County Emergency Housing.
