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MOTION NO. _____

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A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to create Road Improvement District No. 93 for street lights in the plats of Mountain View Villa Div. No. 1 and Spring Vista.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County Council requesting the creation of a road improvement district for providing installation, electric energy, maintenance and operation of street lights; and

WHEREAS, the director of the department of public works has determined that said petition has been signed by owners of an aggregate amount of the majority of the lineal frontage upon the improvement to be made, and of an aggregate amount of the majority of the area within the limits of the assessment district to be created therefor, and that the improvement appears to be feasible, and that the benefits appear to exceed the cost of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found that said petition is sufficient and that the proposed District is sufficiently developed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

It is the intention of the Council to establish, pursuant to the aforesaid petition and pursuant to Chapter 36.88 RCW, a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 93" (hereinafter "RID 93"). It is intended that RID 93 shall include all the territory described as follows:

The plats of Mountain View Villa Division No. 1, and Spring Vista recorded in Volume 79, page 56, and Volume 74, page 90, respectively, of the King County Plats, all located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 17, Township 21 North, Range 5 East, W.M.

1 It is further the intention of the Council to order the
2 improvement of those portions of the following described
3 streets within RID 93 by providing the installation, electric
4 energy, maintenance and operation of street lights:

5 A. SE 327th Street from the westerly boundary of said
6 RID 93;

7 B. SE 326th Place to the easterly boundary of said RID 93.

8 Said improvements are hereafter sometimes referred to
9 collectively as the "Project".

10 The total cost and expense of the Project which is to be
11 borne by all of the property owners within RID 93, is now
12 estimated to be \$34.48 per lot for the first year and \$29.48 per
13 lot for each succeeding year. These costs are based on a King
14 County Office of Finance fee of \$5.00 per account to be
15 assessed the first year, a King County department of public works
16 fee of \$1.50 per account per year and a Puget Sound Power & Light
17 Company fee of \$8.16 per month per light. The final amount of
18 said costs and expense to be borne by said property owners will
19 be determined each year, will be assessed against the benefited
20 private property within the district, with such assessment levied
21 on the basis of equal assessment for each platted building lot.

22 All persons who wish to object to or to otherwise be heard
23 on the creation of proposed Road Improvement District No. 93
24 described herein, on the accomplishment of the Project described
25 herein, or on the assessment of their property for the cost and
26 expenses of accomplishing the Project in the manner described
27 herein, are hereby notified to appear and present their object-
28 ions or testimony at an open public meeting of the King County
29 Council to be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse,
30 Seattle, Washington, at 9:30 a.m. on the 29th day of August,
31 1983. At such time and place, the Council intends to hear
32 such objections and testimony and to act on the intention set
33 forth herein.


1 The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and
 2 directed to give notice of said public hearing by publication
 3 and by mailing at the times and in the manner described in
 4 RCW 36.88.050.

5 The director of the department of public works is hereby
 6 directed to submit to the Council at, or prior to, the date
 7 fixed for said hearing, a diagram or print showing thereon the
 8 lots, tracts, and parcels of land and other property which will
 9 be specially benefited thereby, and the estimated amount of
 10 the cost and expense of said improvement to be borne by each lot,
 11 tract, or parcel of land or other property, and also designating
 12 thereon all property which is being purchased under contract
 13 from the County.

14 "Costs and expenses of accomplishing the Project", as
 15 used herein, shall mean those costs and expenses described
 16 in RCW 36.88.300.
