MOTION NO. 5842

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to enter into a contract with Ronald Sewer District to accomplish the Apple Tree Lane sewer project.

WHEREAS, a serious public health hazard is presented by the current inadequate sewerage system in the Apple Tree Lane area, and

WHEREAS, King County is considering divestment of all sewer operations, including the Richmond Beach system adjacent to Apple Tree Lane, and

WHEREAS, cooperation between King County and the Ronald Sewer District will be helpful in obtaining financing, design, and construction of a sewerage system to solve the health problem, and

WHEREAS, such cooperation can best be accomplished by allowing the Ronald Sewer District to attempt annexation and formation of a ULID at Apple Tree Lane and to pursue federal and state grant funding, and


WHEREAS, the Ronald Sewer District is willing to undertake these responsibilities on the assurance that King County will reimburse certain costs that may be incurred, and accept return of Apple Tree Lane under certain conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


