MOTION NO. 5847

A MOTION remanding to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner the Wolfram (BALD File No. 125-82-R) reclassification request for SR (7200)P to RD 3600 on approximately 5.45 acres in the vicinity of N.E. 132nd and 100th Ave. N.E.

WHEREAS, Keith B. Wolfram (BALD File No. 125-82-R) requested a reclassification of 5.45 acres from SR (7200)P to RD 3600, and

WHEREAS, the request for reclassification is located within the vicinity of N.E. 132nd Street and 100th Ave. N.E. in the Revised Northshore Community Plan area, and

WHEREAS, the Council concluded that the issues raised by the Wolfram request was of current community concern to the County, caused by circumstances not anticipated in the community plan through the application of area zoning guidelines, and

WHEREAS, Motion 5555 requested the Planning Division to prepare a plan revision study pursuant to K.C.C. 20.12.050-.080, and

WHEREAS, the Council concurred that an amendment to the Revised Northshore Community Plan, adopted by Ordinance 5534, was appropriate, and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Ordinance $\underline{653}$ changing the land use designation for the subject property from single family residential to 4 to 6 units per acre to low density/multi-family duplex, and

WHEREAS, it is important that the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner review the reclassification request to ensure that adequate site development conditions are provided, especially for Juanita Creek.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The reclassification request for the Wolfram (BALD File No. 125-82-R) is remanded to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to ensure compliance with Juanita Policy 10 on page 71 of the

Revised Northshore Community Plan, the Juanita Creek Basin Plan, and any other development conditions deemed necessary by the adopted community plan or general county policies and regulations to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the area's residents.
