

MOTION NO. 5890

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Renton for the construction of access road fencing along Northeast Second Street, Renton, and committing to an estimated expenditure of \$4,000.00 in 1984.

WHEREAS, Northeast Second Street is the access road for the new local government center including Renton District Court, City of Renton public works facility and King County public works consolidated shops, and

WHEREAS, the new local government facilities serve residents of both the City of Renton and King County, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of all parties to complete the segment of fence along Northeast Second Street, east of Monroe Avenue Northeast.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County;

Pursuant to RCW 39.34, Interlocal Cooperation Act, the county executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Renton to commit King County's share of the project costs in the amount of approximately \$4,000.00
