A MOTION granting an extension to preliminary approval for the PLAT of INGLEWOOD VILLAGE NO. 3 BALD FILE NO. 680-1

Preliminary approval for the plat of Inglewood Village No. 3 (BALD File No. 680-1) is hereby granted an extension, said extension to expire March 19, 1985.
