A MOTION accepting the recommendations of the Airport Noise Impact Assessment Study for Boeing Field/King County International Airport and requesting the County Executive to submit a program for implementation.

WHEREAS, Motion 5613 re-established the Boeing Field/King County International Airport Noise Advisory Committee and directed it to advise the county in the preparation of a noise impact assessment and a noise abatement plan, and

WHEREAS, the county council provided \$10,000 in the 1981
Budget as a match to obtain Federal Aviation Administration
(FAA) funds to develop a noise impact assessment leading to a comprehensive noise abatement plan, and

Airport Noise Impact Assessment Study For Boeing Field King

County International Airport completed in October of 1983, and
heard a presentation of its findings at the February 3, 1984

meeting of the Committee-of-the-Whole, and

WHEREAS, one of the key findings of the Report is that noise generated by local sources other than Boeing Field--for example, Interstate 5 and Sea-Tac International Airport--affect residents as much as or more than Boeing Field;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

- A. The council expresses its gratitude to the Noise

  Advisory Committee and to the citizens who participated in the public review process and provided valuable input to the preparation of the report.
- B. The council accepts in general the principles expressed in the recommendations contained in the Report.
- C. The council requests the county executive to do the following:
- 1. Prepare a comprehensive program and schedule for the implementation of the recommendations in the Report for council review no later than July 31, 1984.

- 2. Prepare recommendations for specific strategies and programs for dealing with the non-Boeing Field sources of noise such as Sea-Tac Airport and Interstate 5 and submit these for council review no later than July 31, 1984.
- D. The Boeing Field/King County International Airport Noise Advisory Committee is to remain in existence in order to provide input into the implementation of the report's recommendations and into the formulation of strategies dealing with non-Boeing Field sources of noise.
- E. The council recognizes and endorses the concept of intergovernmental cooperation with all governments having jurisdiction over the noise-contributing areas and operations, including the City of Seattle, the Port of Seattle, the State of Washington, and the Federal Government.
